

ECUADOR: PROTECT AMAZONIAN WOMEN DEFENDERS



To: President Daniel Noboa

Officials have yet to bring to justice the people behind death threats and attacks on Amazonian Women Defenders of the Forest. Meanwhile, mining and oil projects are permitted that abuse rights, damage the environment and are linked to increased violence against women. In this context, we call on you to:

- Implement a protection policy for all threatened human rights defenders AND ensure effective investigations of threats and attacks.
- Guarantee the rights of Indigenous Peoples, ensuring that no project goes ahead in their territory without meaningful consultation with them AND their free, prior and informed consent.
- Properly investigate devastating oil spills in the Amazon in 2020 and 2022, guaranteeing justice and reparations for affected communities.
