
ECUADOR: PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE RIGHTS OF AMAZONIAN WOMEN AND GIRLS

We are concerned about state repression of Indigenous communities protesting the impacts of Canadian mining. We are also concerned about the bomb attack outside the home of a teenaged Amazonian climate defender. Meanwhile, climate-destroying gas flares, oil spills and destructive mines are allowed to operate without respect for rights and the environment. In this context, we call on you to:



- Guarantee the rights of Indigenous Peoples, ensuring that no project goes ahead in their territory without meaningful consultation with them AND their free, prior, and informed consent.
- Guarantee the rights and protection of all environment defenders, and bring to justice those who attack them.
