We are concerned about state repression of Indigenous communities protesting the impacts of Canadian mining. We are also concerned about the bomb attack outside the home of a teenaged Amazonian climate defender. Meanwhile, climate-destroying gas flares, oil spills and destructive mines are allowed to operate without respect for rights and the environment. In this context, **we call on you to:**

- Guarantee the rights of Indigenous Peoples, ensuring that no project goes ahead in their territory without meaningful consultation with them AND their free, prior, and informed consent.
- Guarantee the rights and protection of all environment defenders, and bring to justice those who attack them.
