SUDAN: ARMS EMBARGO NOW!

For over a year, the people of Sudan have been neglected and ignored as they bore the brunt of violent clashes between the Sudanese Armed Forces and the Rapid Support Forces. The conflict has killed over 14,500 people and displaced over 8 million, including almost 2 million into neighbouring countries.

Diplomatic efforts have so far failed to end violations, protect civilians, provide sufficient humanitarian aid, or hold perpetrators to account. The UN Security Council must act now to disrupt the flow of arms in Sudan and reduce civilian suffering.
