









# Release Student Oqba Hashad

**To: President of Egypt**

Oqba Hashad, a 27-year-old student, has been held in pretrial detention since May 2019, solely in retaliation for his brother's human rights activism. Egyptian authorities forcibly disappeared and tortured Oqba and continue to deny him the prosthetic leg he has used since a childhood accident, leaving him physically reliant on others. Held in terrible conditions without adequate healthcare, a new bogus case against him has been opened to justify his continued detention.



We demand the immediate and unconditional release of Oqba Hashad.

# Support Women's Human Rights Defenders

In November 2022, Manahel al-Otaibi was arrested for campaigning for women's rights online and posting photos to Snapchat of herself at a shopping mall without wearing a traditional abaya. Saudi Arabia's authorities claim they are advancing women's rights and Manahel felt freer to express her views and wear what she liked. Now she has been sentenced to 11 years in prison.

We demand the immediate and unconditional release of Manahel al-Otaibi and that all charges against her are dropped.
