

# Write for Rights Fundraising Guide

Welcome to Write for Rights!

Every year, Amnesty International mobilizes a global movement to support individuals facing human rights abuses through the power of letter writing. This year, we invite you to take your impact one step further by adding fundraising to your event.

Fundraising not only enhances the impact of your letters but also sustains Amnesty International's vital work—ensuring that we can continue to advocate for human rights worldwide without accepting funding from governments.

# Why Add Fundraising to Your Event?

<u>Amplify Your Impact</u>: Your letters have the power to change lives. By raising funds alongside your advocacy, you ensure that Amnesty has the resources to provide essential support, such as legal aid, advocacy, and relocation services for human rights defenders at risk.

<u>Support Independence</u>: Amnesty's work is funded entirely by individuals like you, ensuring that we remain free to hold governments accountable.

<u>Create Community</u>: Fundraising can rally your friends, family, and community around a shared cause, building awareness and deepening their connection to human rights advocacy.

#### Your Fundraising Plan

Your plan can be as simple or as ambitious as you like!

- Simple: Share a personalized fundraising page with your network via email or social media, and invite people to donate.
- Ambitious: Host a small event, like a trivia night, bake sale, or silent auction, to complement your Write for Rights activity.

A mix of approaches can make fundraising both fun and impactful!

### **Steps to Fundraising Success**

1. Set a Fundraising Goal

Start with a clear, realistic goal—one that inspires you and motivates your network. For example, you might aim to raise \$500:

- \$200 through donations from friends and family.
- \$150 from a bake sale.
- \$150 from a small trivia event.

Feel free to adjust your goal as you see progress. Even small amounts can make a big difference!

### 2. Create a Fundraising Page

We've made fundraising simple with an easy-to-use peer-to-peer platform. Setting up your page takes just a few minutes and makes it easier for supporters to give.

What to include on your page:

- A compelling message about why you're fundraising for Write for Rights.
- A photo of yourself or your event to make it personal.
- Your fundraising goal.

### 3. Map Your Network

Your network is larger than you think! Take a few minutes to map out the people in your life:

- Inner Circle: Close friends, family, and colleagues.
- Extended Circle: Social groups, community organizations, and neighbors.
- Online Circle: Social media followers, email lists, and professional networks.

Reach out personally to people you think would be most likely to donate or share your page. Personal connections make all the difference!

### 4. Share Your Story

People are more likely to give when they understand why the cause matters to you. Use your fundraising page, emails, and social media to share your passion for human rights and your reasons for participating in Write for Rights.

#### Example message:

"This year, I'm participating in Amnesty International's Write for Rights campaign to help advocate for individuals whose rights have been violated. I'm also raising funds to ensure Amnesty can continue its vital work. Will you join me in supporting this incredible cause?"

### 5. Use Social Media to Spread the Word

Social media is a powerful way to reach a wider audience. Post regularly to share updates, thank donors, and remind people of your goal.

Tips for social media success:

- Include photos and personal anecdotes.
- Tag Amnesty International and use hashtags like #Fundraise4Amnesty or #W4R24 #W4RCanada
- Ask friends to share your posts to expand your reach.

# 6. Host a Small Event (aside from letter-writing)

Events are a great way to bring people together and have some fun while raising funds. Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- Bake Sale: Combine your love of baking with your passion for human rights!
- Trivia Night: Host a quiz with an entry fee and prizes for the winning team.
- Silent Auction: Ask local businesses to donate items or services for a cause.
- Themed Party: Invite guests to dress up for a fun evening and collect donations at the door.

Keep it simple, low-cost, and enjoyable. The goal is to build excitement and support for your campaign.

# 7. Ask Directly and Follow Up

The most common reason people don't donate is that they weren't asked! Send personal messages to friends, family, and colleagues, and follow up to remind them.

Pro Tip: Check if your employer has a donation-matching program to double the impact of your efforts.

### 8. Thank Your Supporters

Show gratitude by sending thank-you messages to everyone who donates. Let them know how much their support means to you and to Amnesty. After your event, share the total funds raised, any stories or photos, and the impact it will have.

### **Creative Fundraising Ideas**

- Sponsor Per Letter: Ask supporters to pledge a donation for every letter you write.
- Craft Sale: Sell handmade items like holiday ornaments or greeting cards.
- Vow of Silence: Take a day of silence to raise awareness and funds for those who've been silenced by injustice.
- Game Night: Host a board game or video game tournament with entry fees supporting your goal.
