AGRIDST THE FIRE MODSTERS









The Union of People Affected by Texaco's Oil Operations (UDAPT) is a non-profit organization that brings together communities belonging to six indigenous nationalities (Waorani, Siekopai, Siona, A'l Kofan, Shuar, and Kichwa) and nearly 80 rural communities settled in the area contaminated by oil extraction initiated by the Chevron corporation, formerly Texaco, and now continued by Petroecuador and other transnational companies within the provinces of Orellana and Sucumbíos in the Ecuadorian Amazon.

UDAPT brings together the peoples and communities that in 1993 initiated legal proceedings against the oil company Texaco for environmental, social, and cultural damage caused in the Ecuadorian Amazon region. The plaintiffs against Chevron are part of the UDAPT, which is therefore the organization that legally represents them, in addition to carrying out projects to support the affected communities, implementing comprehensive strategies in defense of human rights and nature.

The collective "Eliminen los mecheros, encendan la vida" (Eliminate the flares, Ignite Life) is composed of the Union of People Affected by Texaco's Oil Operations (UDAPT), the Social Pastoral of the Vicariate of Aguarico and Sucumbíos, Caritas, Ecological Action, Environmental Clinic, the UDAPT women's network, the Yasunidos Collective, Radio Sucumbíos, the Shushufindi Human Rights Committee, the Ángel Shingre Leaders Network, the Capuchin Friars, Radio Ecuador, the Guerreras por la Amazonía (Warrios for the Amazon) collective, CDES, the Alliance of Human Rights Organizations of Ecuador, and a dozen other social collectives in Ecuador.



This material focuses on the struggle of the girls and adolescents who are plaintiffs in the Mecheros (gas flares) case, now known as Guerreras por la Amazonía (Warriors for the Amazon), in their participation in the broader struggle for human rights initiated and sustained by the collective "Eliminate the flares, ignite life," the UDAPT, and thousands of people from affected communities. This material combines elements of fiction and reality in the manhwa format as a way of telling their story.






UNION OF PERSONS AFFECTED BY TEXACO'S OIL OPERATIONS (UDAPT)


WE CAN COVER A LARGER AREA THAT WAY. BUT WE MUST BE CAREFUL.
